### CANBERRA CHURCH OF ENGLAND GIRLS, GRAMMAR SCHOOL (ELECTION AS TRUSTEE) ORDINANCE 1980<sup>1</sup>

#### CONSOLIDATED VERSION

#### AN ORDINANCE

To elect a separate trustee for certain church trust property held for the purposes of the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School.

WHEREAS the lands and other property described in the Schedule are held for the use of the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn for the purposes of the Canberra Church of England Girls, Grammar School:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to elect Canberra Church of England Girls, Grammar School (being a company incorporated in the Australian Capital Territory the objects of which include the object of acting as trustee of church trust property held for the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn) to be the separate trustee of the lands and other property described in the Schedule:

NOW THEREFORE the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all powers vested in it under the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, of New South Wales (in their application in the Australian Capital Territory), ordains, as follows:

#### 1. SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Church of England Girls, Grammar School (Election as Trustee) Ordinance 1980.

#### 2. COMMENCEMENT

- 2.1 This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1st January, 1981.

#### 3. ELECTION OF TRUSTEE

- 3.1 In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1917, of New South Wales in its application in the Australian Capital Territory and of all other powers thereunto enabling, it is hereby determined that there shall be a separate trustee for the church trust property described in the Schedule and that Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School (being the company referred to in the recitals) is hereby elected as the separate trustee of the church trust property so described

#### 4. PAYMENT OF DEBTS

- 4 1 Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School (being the company referred to in the recitals) is hereby authorized and directed to pay and discharge, out of moneys of the company available for the purpose, all debts and obligations connected with the development, maintenance and operation of the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School and incurred before the commencement of this Ordinance that the Board of that school would, but for this Ordinance, have been required to pay and discharge.

#### SCHEDULE

##### Description of Church Trust Property

1. All those pieces and parcels of land comprising-
  - (a) Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 19, section 9, Deakin as described in Crown Lease Volume 66 Folio 6547<sup>2</sup>
  - (b) Blocks 2 and 3, Section 49, Deakin as described in Crown Lease Volume 804 Folio 94<sup>3</sup>
- 2 The buildings erected on the land described in paragraph 1 and used for or in connection with the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School.
- 3 The fixtures and furnishings of the buildings referred to in paragraph 2, and the furniture, equipment, vehicles and trading stock of the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School.
- 4 Moneys held by the Board of the Canberra Church of England Girls, Grammar School (whether in cash, with a bank or a deposit with a bank, fund or other body) for the maintenance and operation of that School, and investments held by the Board of that School or the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn and representing moneys so held not immediately required for the maintenance and operation of that school less an amount of \$569,360.
- 5 Debts due to the Board of the Canberra Church of England Girls, Grammar School or the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn in respect of the maintenance and operation of that school.
