THE CANBERRA GRAMMAR SCHOOL ACQUISITION ORDINANCE OF 1949¹

AN ORDINANCE

To authorise the Church Of England Property Trust Diocese of Goulburn to acquire the Canberra Grammar School.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS Canberra Grammar School (a Company or Association not for gain and limited by guarantee duly incorporated under Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909, Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910 and Companies Act 1899 and 1900 (New South Wales) and having its registered office at Canberra in the Australian Capital Territory) has offered the Canberra Grammar School (hereinafter called "The School") together with all attendant assets and liabilities to the Church of England within the Diocese of Goulburn.

AND WHEREAS the Twenty-third Synod of the Diocese of Goulburn in its second session accepted the said offer and resolved that its Standing Committee be empowered to to make and to do all such acts as may be necessary to carry into effect the transfer of the School from the Association to the Diocese of Goulburn.

NOW THEREFORE the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Goulburn in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitution for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all powers vested in the said Synod by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 declares, directs, rules and ordains as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Grammar School Acquisition Ordinance of 1949.

2. TRANSFER OF SCHOOL

- 2.1 The Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Goulburn (hereinafter called the Trust) is hereby directed and empowered accept and take over by transfer assignment or otherwise from Canberra Grammar School as a going concern the undertaking or establishment known as the Canberra Grammar School and the whole of the assets and liabilities of every description of the said School as at the date of completion of transfers and to make and do all such acts matters transfers assignments, instruments, writings, measures and things as may be necessary to carry into effect and complete the acquisition thereof.
- 2.2 As from the date of completion of transfers the Trust shall stand possessed of the undertaking comprising the School and all the property both real and personal comprising the assets of the Association (but subject to any mortgage debt subsisting thereon at the said date of completion) upon trust for the Diocese of Goulburn and shall hold the same subject to the terms and conditions of any Ordinance or Ordinances passed by the Synod of the Diocese in that behalf.
