THE CANBERRA CHURCH OF ENGLAND GIRLS GRAMMAR SCHOOL ACQUISITION ORDINANCE OF 1957¹

AN ORDINANCE

To authorise the Church Of England Property Trust Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn to acquire the Canberra Church of England Girls Grammar School.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the Canberra Church of England Girls Grammar School (a Company or Association not for gain and limited by guarantee duly incorporated under Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909, Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910 and Companies Act 1899 and 1900 (New South Wales) and having its registered office at Canberra in the Australian Capital Territory) may offer the Canberra Church of England Girls Grammar School (hereinafter called The School) together with all attendant assets and liabilities to the Church of England within the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn.

AND WHEREAS the Twenty-third Synod of the Diocese of Goulburn in its second session resolved that its Standing Committee be authorised and instructed to take all necessary steps to pass any necessary ordinances required to take over the whole responsibility of the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School if requested to do so by the School.

AND WHEREAS the Synod of the Diocese of Goulburn on the eighteenth day of April 1950 passed the Diocesan Titles Ordinance whereby it was enacted that the Diocese of Goulburn was thenceforth to be called and known as the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn.

NOW THEREFORE the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all powers vested in the said Synod by the Church of England Trust Property Act of 1917 declares, directs, rules and ordains as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School Acquisition Ordinance of 1957.

2. TRANSFER OF SCHOOL

- 2.1 The Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn (hereinafter called the Trust) is hereby directed and empowered at such time as it may determine to acquire accept and take over by transfer assignment or otherwise from Canberra Church of England Girls Grammar School as a going concern the undertaking or establishment known as the Canberra Church of England Girls' Grammar School and the whole of the assets and liabilities of every description of he said School as at the date of completion of transfers and to make and do all such acts matters transfers assignments instruments writings measures and things as may be necessary to carry into effect and complete the acquisition thereof.
- 2.2 As from the date of completion of transfers the Trust shall stand possessed of the undertaking comprising the School and all the property both real and personal comprising the assets of the Company (but subject to any debt subsisting thereon at the said date of completion) upon rust for the Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn and shall hold the same subject to the terms and conditions of any Ordinance or Ordinances passed by the Synod of the Diocese in that behalf.
